A Notice of Appeal was received on February 13, 2023 from Centurion Canadian Infrastructure (formerly Site Equipment Ltd.), with respect to the January 27, 2023 decision of the Director, Forestry, Parks and Tourism, to refuse amendment applications from Site Equipment Ltd. (now Centurion Canadian Infrastructure) for Surface Material Leases SML 980089, SML 980090, SML 980092 and SML 980093 for sand and gravel located at SW-34-065-02-W4M, NW-34-065-02-W4M, SW-26-065-02-W4M and SW-27-065-02-W4M. The Director made the decision to discontinue over-holding tenancy, refuse to renew, and cancel the SMLs and associated access under expired DLO 981399 and DLO 981594.

On March 23, 2023, the Board advised that based on the available dates provided by the parties, a mediation meeting was scheduled for May 11, 2023 by Webex videoconference.

As the mediation did not result in the appeals being resolved, on May 11, 2023 the Appellant was asked to advise if they wanted to proceed to a virtual hearing or a written hearing.

On July 5, 2023, the Appellant advised they were withdrawing their appeals.

Based upon the withdrawal of the appeal by Centurion Canadian Infrastructure, the Board discontinued its proceedings and closed its files on July 6, 2023.
