**Facts**

The Appellants, Derrick and Josie L'Heureux, filed a Notice of Appeal with the Public Lands Appeal Board on May 6, 2016 appealing an alleged deemed rejection of surface material exploration (SME) 150100. The Appellant alleged that the Director who made the decision is deemed to have rejected the application under section 15 of the Public Lands Administration Regulation.

On July 14, 2016, a mediation session was held at which an agreement was reached and the Appellant withdrew its appeal.

On July 18, 2016, the Board wrote to the parties accepting the withdrawal and informing the parties that the Board was closing its files in PLAB 16-0011.

**Rationale for Discontinuance**

As the Appellant has withdrawn the notice of appeal, and as the Board is satisfied that all issues relating to the appeal have been resolved in accordance with section 123(8) of the *Public Lands Act*, the Public Lands Appeal Board discontinues its proceedings and closes its file for PLAB 16-0011.
